**1.1 PROJECT DESCRIPTION.**

This Project envisages for .....

**NOTE: KPTCL has invited the bid on total price basis & KPTCL has provided the amount put to Tender. The bidders are advised to quote only the total price inclusive of all taxes, duties and levies for the said work in the *Price Schedule*. While quoting, it is the responsibility of the bidder to consider the correct rates of duties, taxes and levies on the equipment/material/work prevailing at the time of bidding.**

**As it is a total price basis Tender, the amount put to tender is based on the rates as per prevailing KPTCL SR & updated rates as per CACMAI/IEEMA (where ever applicable) & these rates are inclusive of all taxes, duties, cess along with F&I.**

**1.2 SCOPE OF WORK:**

The scope of works under this IFB covers .....

The salient features of the Scope include, but not limited to, the following:

- a) Overall Project Management, Coordination.
- b) Conducting check survey of the detailed survey that is already conducted by KPTCL & also conducting detailed theodolite survey, if any discrepancy is noticed in the earlier detailed survey or deviation of line route if found necessary at the time of execution due to various field problems.
- c) Preparation of fabrication drawings and shop drawings, fabrication and supply of towers as per standard drawing and bill of materials that would be furnished to the successful bidder. No design and testing is envisaged. Higher steel sections can be used with prior approval, but payment will be limited to ceiling weights that are indicated in the technical specification and bill of materials.
- d) Supply of conductor, insulators, ground wire, conductor accessories, earthing sets, number plates, phase plates, danger boards and all other materials required for completeness of the line.
- e) Excavation, casting of tower foundation, stub setting, erection of complete towers with extensions and fixing of all accessories, hoisting of insulators, stringing of conductor and ground wire, fixing of line hardware including all Civil and Structural works as per specification.
- f) The detailed foundation drawings will be furnished to the successful bidder. The foundation quantities are specified in the Technical Specification/ Schedule of quantities. The variation in the specified quantities and actual quantities shall be settled on the basis of unit rates.
- g) All statutory clearance, wherever required shall be arranged by the owner. The Bidder should clear any way leave problems, but the owner shall extend all required support in this regard.
- h) Tree cutting and its compensation, crop compensation shall be arranged and paid by the Bidder as per the bills preferred by Owner. The owner shall reimburse the compensation so paid.
- i) Land leveling, design, engineering and execution of earth mat, control room building, cable ducts, roads, foundations for station structures, support structures and equipments, providing water supply and sanitary arrangements, security fencing with gate, drainage etc.
- j) Design, engineering, manufacture, factory testing, supply on FOR Destination to site basis, transportation, insurance, unloading, storing, handling and moving into the final position, erection, installation, testing, commissioning and putting the

equipment into successful commercial operation of both Sub-Station and Transmission line including associated structural and Civil Works.

Issues on which clarifications are sought by the Prospective Bidders shall be submitted in writing to the Chief Engineer, Electy., .....Zone on or before the date and time as mentioned in the e-Procurement platform. Letters seeking clarifications received subsequent to this date will not be entertained. Interested Bidders may also submit online queries through the e-Procurement platform and need to mention their firm credentials along with online queries.

- 3.0 As stated in clause 1.0 supra, the bids are invited and to be submitted through e-Procurement Platform only. The Bid Notification, Bidding Documents along with Drawings are available on website [www.kptcl.com](http://www.kptcl.com) with hyperlink 'eProcurement - KPTCL' or <https://eproc.karnataka.gov.in>. Tender documents along with drawings and bidding formats are available 'Free of Cost' to bidders. Bidders need to pay tender processing fee and earnest money deposit through any of the 4 modes of e-Payment as mentioned in this document

#### 4.0 Bid Security (Earnest Money Deposit)

- 4.1 Bids shall be accompanied by tender processing fee, for an amount as mentioned in the e-Procurement platform and Bid Security (EMD) for an amount of **Rs. Lakhs** as follow;

##### 4.1.1 **Up to Rs. 10.00 Lakhs**

The Payment of the same shall be made through any of the following modes of e-Payment.

##### **NOTE:-**

EMD payment at E-procurement portal is through ICICI bank. **For further clarification, contact E-procurement portal.**

4.1.2 Balance Rs. **Nil Lakhs** in the form of Bank Guarantee valid for 30 days beyond the prescribed Period of validity for the Bid including Period of Extension, if any. **The bidder shall scan the bank guarantee towards EMD and upload the same in the prescribed form failing which the offer will be rejected. Also, the Bidders shall ensure that the bank**

**guarantee towards EMD shall be sent in original to the Chief Engineer Electy., .....TZ, KPTCL so as to reach after the last submission date & on or before the date & time of opening Techno commercial Bids in a sealed cover, failing which their bid will not be opened.**

**4.1.3** Government/Quasi Government /Public Sector Undertakings are not exempted from furnishing the Bid security. However, GOI / GOK undertakings like MECON, KAVIKA, MEI etc., are allowed to pay the stipulated EMD against individual tenders as follows:

**4.1.3.1:** Rs. 1,000=00 (Rs. One thousand only) in any of the forms as per clause no. 4.1.1 above.

**4.1.3.2:**

Balance amount of EMD over and above Rs. 1,000=00 in the form of Bank Guarantee Valid for 30 days beyond the prescribed Period of validity for the bid including period of extension, if any. **The bidder shall scan the Bank Guarantee towards EMD and upload the same in the prescribed form failing which the offer will be rejected. Also, the Bidders shall ensure that the Bank Guarantee towards EMD shall be sent in original to the Chief Engineer Electy., .....TZ, KPTCL so as to reach after the last submission date & on or before the date & time of opening Techno commercial Bids in a sealed cover, failing which their bid will not be opened.**

**4.2** Bank Guarantee towards EMD over and above Rs. 10.00 Lakhs as per Annexure-II of the bid document shall be sent in original to Chief Engineer Electy., .....Transmission Zone, KPTCL so as to reach *after the last submission date & on or* before the date & time of opening Techno commercial Bids. The hard copy of the following Documents duly signed by authorized Persons shall also be submitted along with Bank Guarantee (if any).

**Note:**

- a) **The Bid Enquiry No. shall be clearly and legibly indicated in the Bank Guarantee.**
- b) **The Bid Enquiry number shall be super scribed on the Sealed cover.**

**4.3** **Bids not accompanied with requisite Tender Processing Fee and Bid security are liable for rejection.**

**5.0**

- a) Bids shall be submitted in two parts viz., (1) Techno -Commercial Bid and (2) Price Bid both on Electronic Mode. Manual bids will not be accepted.



b) Separate document files have been specifically created for uploading the following qualifying documents.

- IV. Power of Attorney in favor of all the persons signing the documents,
- V. Audited financial statements,
- VI. Works on hand details,
- VII. Valid Super Grade Electrical License issued by GOK as on the date of opening of techno-commercial bid.
- VIII. Certificate of Incorporation of all the participating companies in case of registered companies / Partnership deed in case of Partnership Firm.
- IX. GSTIN registration Certificate and Pan Card
- X. No Deviation Certificate,

- XIII. Self declaration regarding Litigation w.r.t KPTCL contracts over the last five years (refer clause 10.0).

- XIV. Self declaration for ‘not being disqualified regarding non-performance in any of the Government utilities in the past five years’. (refer clause 11.1)
- XV. An undertaking to source the supply of equipment/material from KPTCL approved Vendors only as per the QR for Vendor registration, available in the KPTCL website i.e., [www.kptcl.com](http://www.kptcl.com), Link Tendering & Procurement - application for Vendor registration.
- XVI. Self declaration regarding Risk & Cost.

These qualifying documents are to be uploaded to the respective files only, IF ANY OF DOCUMENTS ARE UPLOADED TO THE FILE OTHER THAN THE SPECIFIED FILES, SUCH DOCUMENTS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED FOR EVALUATION AND OFFERS OF SUCH BIDDERS ARE LIABLE FOR REJECTION. If any of the documents are not applicable to a particular Bidder, then such Bidders have to upload a document stating “Not Applicable”. The other documents if any which needs to be uploaded by the Bidder for which no specific files have been created to substantiate or to meet the requirements of the bids, such additional documents may be uploaded in the folder named as “additional documents” in the e-Procurement portal..

**No hard copy/copies of additional documents other than those already uploaded will be entertained**

- 6.0** Bids shall be uploaded on to e-procurement platform before the date and time notified in the e-procurement platform..  
The Bidders shall upload credentials in support of their Technical capacity, Financial Strength and Past Experience.
- 7.0** The Techno- Commercial Bids will be opened On the date and time notified in the e-procurement platform.
- 8.0** The Price Bids of those Bidders whose Techno-Commercial Bids are found **Responsive** will be opened at a later date under intimation to the Qualified Bidders, either by regular Mail or by E Mail.
- 9.0** The Bidders shall provide credentials in support of their Technical capacity, Financial Strength and Past Experience.

**10.0** Karnataka Power Transmission Corporation Limited, takes no responsibility for delay, due to any cyber or any other computer related problems. Further, KPTCL reserves the right to reject any or all the Bids without assigning any reasons thereof and shall bear no liability whatsoever consequent upon such a decision.

The Bidder is required to ensure browser compatibility of the computer well in advance to the last date and time for receipt of tenders. The department shall not be responsible for non-accessibility of e-procurement portal due to internet connectivity issues and technical glitches.

**Litigation:**

The bidder should provide detailed information on any litigation or arbitration arising out of contracts completed or under execution by it over the last five years with KPTCL. A history of awards involving litigations against the bidder or any party or JV may result in rejection of bid.

Bidders are requested to furnish the self-declaration stating the above and upload the same along with the other documents in the relevant field in the e-procurement portal, failing which the offer is liable to be rejected.

**11.0 QUALIFYING REQUIREMENTS (QR):**

**11.1 GENERAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Bidder shall be financially sound and shall submit audited financial reports for last five years preceding the date of bid submission. Bidder shall have adequate knowledge of Sub-Stations and Transmission Lines design procedures including quality control and shall have infrastructure and erection facilities and capacity to execute the works.

The documentary proof of fulfilling the qualifying requirements shall be uploaded along with the bid. The Bidder shall upload the performance certificates issued by the end users not below the rank of Executive /Divisional Engineer along with the bid.

The bidder should not have been disqualified for non-performance in any of the Government utilities in the past five years and bidder shall furnish a self-declaration to this effect, failing which the offer is liable to be rejected.

**Risk & Cost:**

The offer of the bidder or his Consortium partner is liable for rejection in following cases:

- i) Where the Zonal Chief Engineers/CEE(T&P) have issued notices in respect of ongoing works in the last 6 months as on date of bid submission invoking 'Risk & Cost clause and where the work is not completed/ charged.
- ii) Where the zonal Chief Engineers/ CEE(T&P) have issued notices in the last 6 months as on date of bid submission invoking 'Risk & Cost' clause and where the work is completed by KPTCL entrusting it to some other agency.

iii)Wherein the works awarded by KPTCL to the bidder has been short closed invoking clause No.44.0 & 45.0 of GCC (Contractors default) then such bidder shall not be eligible if such short closure has been initiated within 6 months prior to last date of bid submission of this tender.

Bidder and his consortium partners shall furnish self-declaration stating that no such actions against the bidder/his consortium partners have been taken by KPTCL in respect of i), ii) & iii) above and upload the same along with other documents in relevant field in the e-procurement portal failing which the offer is liable to be rejected.

**NOTE:** However, if the bidder after issue of 'Risk & Cost notice completes the works successfully and if the same is commissioned (before opening of the bid), in such cases the offer of the bidder would be considered.

**The essential minimum Qualifying Requirements are as under:**

**11.2** The Bidder or his consortium partner should possess valid **Super grade** Electrical Contractor's License issued by the Government of Karnataka as on the date of opening of techno-commercial bid.

In addition, the bidder should have the following qualifying requirements (Technical):

**11.3 Qualifying Requirements for sub-stations:-**

a) Should have carried out erection of all connected equipments of (01) One Transformer Bay of 110/66KV class or above voltage class on Total Turnkey or Partial Turnkey basis, including erection of Transformer, which shall be in satisfactory service for a period of One year prior to date of submission of the Bid.

OR

b) Should have carried out erection of all connected equipments of 02(Two) Transformer Bays of 110/66KV class or above voltage class on Labour Contract or as Sub-Contract to any Turnkey Contractor including erection of Transformer in each terminal bay work, which shall be in satisfactory service for a period of One year prior to date of submission of the Bid.

Note 1: The Labour Contractor or Sub-Contractor of a Turnkey Contractor shall also furnish/upload the following in support of the qualifying requirement.

a) Copy of the letter of approval (permission) issued by the awarding agency to the turnkey contractor (main), permitting the Turnkey Contractor (main) to sub-let the awarded work to the said Labour Contractor or Sub - Contractor.

- b) Copy of the work award issued by the Turnkey Contractor (main) to the said Labour Contractor or Sub-Contractor.
- c) The agreement between the Turnkey Contractor (main) and the said Labour Contractor or Sub-Contractor.

#### **11.5 CONSORTIUM :-** *(Limited to a maximum of Two(2) Constituents including the Lead bidder)*

**CONSORTIUM:-** *(Limited to a maximum of Two(2) Constituents including the Lead bidder) :-*

11.5.3 *The Prime Bidder who meets not less than 60% of the Financial Capabilities as specified in '11.6.1' and technical qualifying requirement prescribed in 11.3 is eligible to participate in the tender with consortium arrangement limited to a maximum of two (2) members including the prime bidder subject to entering in to a joint consortium agreement in the prescribed format (Annexure-XI). However, the Consortium shall collectively meet Technical and Financial qualifying requirements prescribed in 11.3 and 11.6.*

*(I) Any one of the Consortium Partners shall meet the Technical Capability prescribed at 11. 3.*

*(II) Financial requirement prescribed at 11.6 shall be met by any of the consortium partners or jointly by both the partners of the consortium.*

11.5.4 **Both** the signatories of the consortium agreement shall be only those holding valid power of attorney. A certified copy by the Company Secretary/Authorised Signatory to the respective members of the consortium shall be attached as evidence for authentication.

One of the members of the consortium shall be nominated as leader (Prime Bidder) of the consortium and authorization shall be evidenced by submitting a power of attorney signed by signatories of **both** the members of consortium.

The leader of the consortium shall be the only one who will be authorised to receive the instructions for and on behalf of the consortium. The leader of the consortium is primarily responsible for the total execution of the contract including all contractual obligations and receipt of the payment due in accordance with the provision of the contract.

**Both** the members of the consortium shall be liable jointly and severally for the execution of the contract in accordance with the terms and conditions of the contract and a statement to this effect shall be included in the consortium agreement as well as in the contract agreement.

There shall be no conditional offer in the consortium agreement with regard to the project.

The contract agreement between Purchaser and Consortium shall be signed by **both the** members of the consortium.

The Consortium formed for the purpose of the project shall be valid till completion of the contract.

“On specific request by the leader of the consortium i.e. lead partner/lead member, the CEE,.....TZ, KPTCL may consider the request for arranging direct payment to consortium partner for his scope of work duly obtaining the necessary joint undertaking from the members of the consortium and to accept the general correspondences such as approval of Drawings /GTP/ Type tests, Inspection calls, Site inspections etc., made directly by their consortium partners”.

## 11.6 FINANCIAL CAPABILITIES:

For the purpose of this particular Bid, Bidders shall collectively meet the following minimum criteria:

- 11.6.1 *Minimum Average Annual Turnover (MAAT) of the bidder for best three years out of last preceding five financial years ending on March or December as the case may be, shall not be less than Rs .....Lakh which is calculated as noted below;*

$$Rs = \frac{(1.5 \times \text{estimated cost})}{\text{Completion period in years.}}$$

*In case completion period is less than one (1) year the denominator to calculate MAAT shall be considered as one (1).*

*In case bidder is a holding company, MAAT shall be that of holding company only (i.e. excluding its subsidiary / group companies). In case bidder is a subsidiary of a holding company, MAAT shall be that of subsidiary company only (i.e. excluding its holding company)*

## **11.6.2 Basis for assessing the Financial Capability:**

- 11.6.2.1 For assessing the Financial Capability of the Bidder, balance Works on hand (of the bidder including that of his consortium members who are extending financial support) with KPTCL and other commitments of the Bidder will be taken into account. In computing the same, such of those works of KPTCL entrusted to the Bidder and where the percentage of financial progress is more than 50%, the same shall not be reckoned while assessing the Financial Capability of the Bidder concerned. For NON KPTCL works, the value of the pending portion of the works on hand will be reckoned.
- 11.6.2.2 If the Bidder's company is having various wings / Divisions and the turnover of each of the wing / Division are audited separately and have separate resources, in such events the turnover and commitments of that wing / Division which deals with KPTCL will be taken in to account for assessing the financial capability.
- 11.6.2.3 While computing the balance works on hand pertaining to KPTCL, only those works where the financial progress is less than 50% shall be reckoned on the entire award amount.
- 11.6.2.4 The Bidder shall stand disqualified if the total value of Works on hand including contract against subject tender if awarded, exceeds 2 times the MAAT (minimum average annual turn over).
- 11.6.2.5 The bidder shall clearly furnish the details of the quantum of works to be executed with KPTCL duly indicating the financial progress as on the last day of the previous month of date of Bid submission and the quantum of works on hand with the other clients of the Bidder as stated in the above clauses which are considered for arriving Bidder Company's annual turnover duly certified by the Company's Chartered Accountant.
- 11.6.2.6 In the event of the Bidder failing to furnish the financial turnover and the financial commitments along with the offer or furnishes the incorrect information, the offers of such Bidders will be rejected.

### **11.6.2.7 Restriction on KPTCL works on Hand:**

## **11.7 General**

- 11.7.1** Notwithstanding the above, if it is found that the performance vis – a - vis works awarded to the Bidder by KPTCL is either behind schedule or not satisfactory, KPTCL will be at liberty to disqualify the Bidder and reject its Bid at the time of techno-commercial evaluation.
- 11.7.2** A Bidder shall submit only one tender in the same tendering process. No Bidder can be a Consortium Partner in case he submits a tender individually in the same tendering process. A Consortium Partner shall not be a partner for more than one Bidder in the same Tendering process in that case both or all such offers will be rejected and also in case a Prime / Lead Bidder becomes a Consortium Partner for another Bidder in the same Tendering process then both or all such offers will be rejected.
- 11.7.3** If the information furnished by the Bidder / Bidders is found to be false at any stage of tendering / execution, then KPTCL, at its discretion may take action against such Bidder / Bidders. If false information is found at the Tendering stage KPTCL may forfeit the EMD paid, disqualify the offer of such Bidder, Black list the Firm etc., and if false information is found at execution stage then KPTCL may cancel the works awarded , forfeit the Bank Guarantee furnished against the performance of the contract, Black list the Firm, besides initiating action for recovery of excess money paid by KPTCL, if any, after getting the works executed from other contractors, levy liquidated damages etc. ,
- 11.7.4** If part or full price sheets or prices are exposed in the Techno-Commercial Sheets or Techno-Commercial Bid by the Bidder, then the offer of the Bidder will be rejected.

## **11.8 PUBLIC SECTOR COMPANIES:**

- 11.8.1** Public Owned Enterprises domiciled in the Owner / Lessee Country may be eligible to qualify if, in addition to meeting all the above requirements, and also:
- a) Are Commercially oriented Legal Entities distinct from the Owner/Lessee, and are not a Government Department.
  - b) Are financially autonomous, as demonstrated by requirements in their constitutions to provide separate audited accounts and return on Capital, powers to raise loans and obtain Revenues through the sale of Goods or services and
  - c) Are Managerially autonomous.
- 11.8.2** PSU's shall note that No preference / advantage of whatever nature will be given in evaluation / comparison of Bids and in Award of Contract.



**11.9 QUALIFYING REQUIREMENT OF MANUFACTURER OF EQUIPMENTS TO BE SUPPLIED BY THE CONTRACTOR:**

- a) The Sub-Vendor should have a minimum experience of 5 years in Designing, Manufacturing, Testing and Supply of the Equipments of similar Rating, Capacity to the ones specified and being offered. At least twice the Quantity of the Equipments/ Materials covered in the Scope of this Bid identified to be supplied by the Contractor, should have been Manufactured by the Sub-Vendor. At least 50% of the Quantity as specified above Manufactured by the firm, should be in successful Operation for at least two years as on the date of Bid opening.

**OR**

- b) Manufacturers who are subsidiaries and have recently established production line in India for the equipments/ materials covered in the Scope of this Bid identified to be supplied by the Contractor, can also be considered as meeting with the criteria, provided the Parent Company (Principals ) who posses QR as mentioned above agrees to furnish, along with the Bid, either jointly with the Sub-Vendor (Subsidiary) or separately, a legally enforceable undertaking to guarantee quality, timely supply, performance and warranty obligations as specified for the contract and also furnish performance certificate for the Satisfactory operation of individual equipment. Such guarantee (warranty) for the Equipment to be supplied shall be for a period of 24 Months from the date of commissioning or 36 Months from the date of supply of equipment in complete condition, whichever is earlier.

The proforma of Annexure VII (from page 1 of 2 to 2 of 2), Vol. I of bid document, duly filled and duly signed by authorised persons shall be uploaded.

- c) KPTCL, from time to time, may issue circulars indicating the Approved Vendors in respect of certain equipments/materials. In respect of such Vendors, the Total / Partial Turnkey Contractor need not furnish the qualifying data. Present list of approved sub-vendors for various materials / equipments has been annexed as Annexure-XVI.

**12.0 COMMISSIONING PERIOD**

For work involving Replacement of Power Transformer: COMMISSIONING PERIOD IS 6 (SIX) MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF LETTER OF INTENT TO AWARD THE CONTRACT OR 2 (TWO) MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF SUPPLY OF POWER TRANSFORMER/SWITCHGEAR BY KPTCL WHICHEVER IS LATER INCLUDING MONSOON PERIOD.

For work involving construction of Transformer Bay including erection of Power Transformer and switchgear: COMMISSIONING PERIOD IS 9 (NINE) MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF LETTER OF INTENT TO AWARD THE CONTRACT OR 2 (TWO) MONTHS FROM THE DATE OF SUPPLY OF POWER TRANSFORMER/SWITCHGEAR BY KPTCL WHICHEVER IS LATER INCLUDING MONSOON PERIOD.

**13.0** Before Bidding for the above Works of the Sub-Station / Transmission Line, the Bidder shall fully familiarize himself with the Site conditions and General arrangements, etc. Though the Owner shall endeavor to provide the information, it shall not be binding for the Owner to provide the same. The Bidders are advised to visit the Sub-Station / Transmission Line Site and acquaint themselves with the Topography, infrastructure, Soil conditions and Design Philosophy. The Bidders shall be fully responsible for providing all equipments, materials, system and services specified in their scope or otherwise which are required to complete the construction and successful commissioning of the Sub-Station / Transmission Line in all respects in this package. Non- familiarity with the site conditions will not be considered for extra claims and for not carrying out the work in strict conformity with Drawings and Specifications.

**14.0 Notwithstanding anything stated above or elsewhere in the Tender specifications, KPTCL reserves right to assess the Capability / suitability of the Bidder to perform the overall contract should the circumstances warrant such assessment in the overall interest of KPTCL.**

KPTCL reserves its right to vary or modify any tender condition for reasons to be recorded, in case it becomes necessary.
