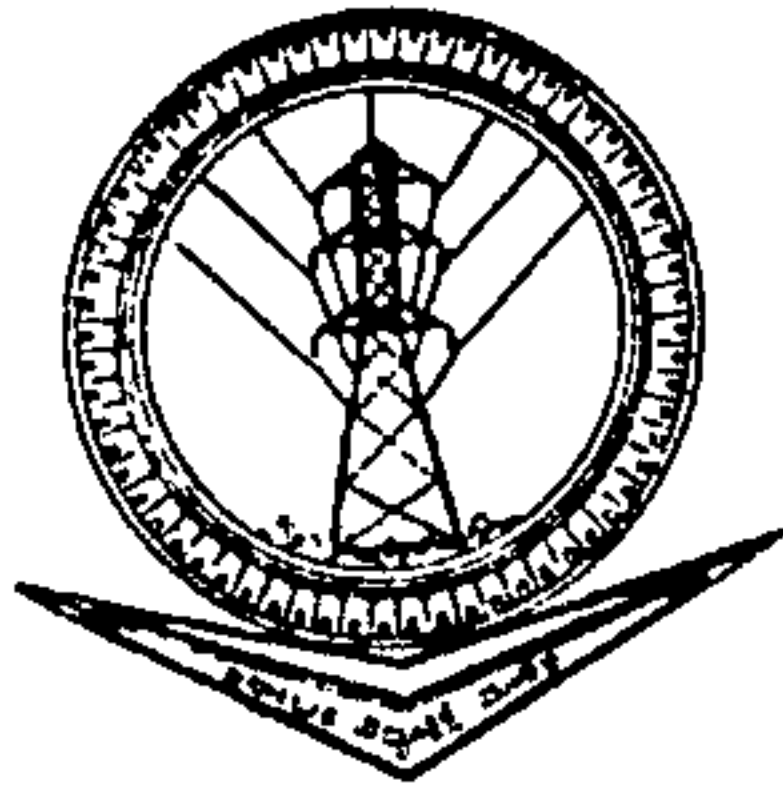

K.E.B. EMPLOYEES' MEDICAL ATTENDANCE REGULATIONS

The following Regulations called "The K.E.B. Employees' Medical Attendance Regulations" are prescribed for regulating the Reimbursement Of Medical Expenses incurred by the Employee.

1. **APPLICATION:** These Regulations shall apply to:
- a) All Employees, whether
On Duty
Or
On Leave [including leave preparatory to retirement]
Or
On Deputation within the State or outside the State but within India
Or
Under Suspension
 - b) Pensioners Re-Employed
 - c) *Persons Appointed On Contract Basis [*B4/986/79 - 80/ 7.8. 1980]
 - d) The Family Of The Employee

EXPLANATION: For the purpose of these Regulations "FAMILY" means:

- i) THE WIFE OR THE HUSBAND:
- ii) The FATHER, MOTHER, STEPMOTHER wholly dependent on the Employee if they ordinarily reside with him/her and their total monthly income does not exceed Rs. 390-00* per month [B16/7747//87-88/ 11.12.1987]

AND

- iii) CHILDREN including adopted children and stepchildren of an employee who are wholly dependent on such employee.

2. a) In the case of an Employee whose husband or wife is employed elsewhere and the latter is in receipt of a fixed allowance, monthly or annual towards medical charges/ expenses or is eligible for the reimbursement of medical expenses or is covered by ESI Scheme or any other parallel scheme, Such an employee is generally Not Entitled to the reimbursement of medical expenses under these Regulations.

b) However, with a view to avoid financial hardship to an employee in such cases, the claim of an employee for reimbursement of medical expenses may be regulated as indicated hereunder:

i) Where the spouse of an employee is working in some other Department/organisation and is eligible for reimbursement of medical expenses as in KEB -

The medical expenses of self/children/dependants of the employee excluding the claims of HIS/HER spouse may be admitted as per these Regulations provided the employee obtains and produces a certificate from the competent authority of the concerned Department/ Organisation in which HIS/HER spouse is working that the spouse has given a written undertaking that the claims for reimbursement of medical expenses incurred by the Board employee and his/her children/ dependants will not be preferred by the spouse in his/ her department/organisation.

NOTE: THE ABOVE PROVISION IS EQUALLY APPLICABLE TO BOARD EMPLOYEE WHOSE SPOUSE IS ALSO A BOARD EMPLOYEE.

ii) Where the spouse of the Employee is working in some other department/organisation and is in receipt of

FIXED ALLOWANCE monthly or annually towards medical expenses of his/her family;

only the self medical claims of the employee excluding the claims of His/Her spouse, children and dependants may be admitted as per these Regulations.

- iii) Where the spouse of the employee is working in some other department/organisation and is covered under ESI Scheme or any other parallel scheme;

the medical claims of self/children/dependants of the employee excluding the claims of HIS/HER spouse may be admitted as per these Regulations, provided that the NAMES of the Employee, HIS/HER children and dependents are deleted from the ESI card or equivalent card and a certificate to that effect is obtained from concerned authority and produced by the Employee.

Note: 1. The Certificate produced by the Employee should be pasted in his/her Service Register/Service Record.

2. The correctness of the certificate should be got verified by the Pay Drawing Officers.

3. **DEFINITIONS:** In these Regulations unless the context otherwise requires:

A. **AUTHORISED MEDICAL ATTENDANT** means:-

- i) A MEDICAL OFFICER, who is a Gazetted Government Employee working in a Government Hospital or in a Government Medical Institution in the case of all Employees.

Gazetted Government Officers:

District Medical Officer

Civil Surgeon

District Health Officer
Dean of Medical College/Hospital
Medical Superintendent
Professors in Government Medical College
Or any Medical Officer of Gazetted Rank.

- ii) In the case of those Employees working in or outside the TALUK HEAD QUATERS, Medical Officers Gazetted or Non-Gazetted, incharge of Primary Health Units/Centres of the place, where the Employee is working .
- iii) Board's Medical Consultants *[A1/2282/73-74/13.11.1973]
- iv) MEDICAL OFFICERS/HMO, HAMO'S/Part time MO's attached to the Private Recognised or approved Hospitals/ Institutions

Semi-Government Hospitals & Charitable Hospitals recognised and approved by the Board. Such Hospitals are listed in Appendix - A.

All bills must be Countersigned by head of respective Institutions.

- B. Controlling Officers, for the purpose of claims for reimbursement of expenditure incurred in connection with Medical Attendance means:

“The officers who are empowered to countersign the Travelling Allowance Bills of the Employees concerned.”

[See Reg. No. 311 of BESR]

- C. FORM means a Form appended to these Regulations.

- D. HOSPITAL means:

a Hospital or)

a Primary Health Centre or)

- a Primary Health Unit or)
- a Medical Institution or) run by the STATE GOVERNMENT
- a Semi - Government Hospital or) UNION GOVERNMENT
- a Charitable Hospital or)
- a Private Medical Institution

Recognised and approved by the Board (See Appendix - "A") from time to time, for purposes of treatment and for reimbursement of Medical Charges/Expenses.

- E. **MEDICAL ATTENDANCE** means Attendance in a recognised Hospital/Dispensary [i.e., at the Out Patient Dept. or in the case of an illness which compels the Patient to be confined to his/her residence, at the residence of the employee, including the pathological, Bacteriological, Radiological or other methods of examination for purposes of Diagnosis, as are available in any Hospital within the STATE OF KARNATAKA and are considered necessary by the Authorised Medical Attendant and such consultation with a specialist in Govt. Employment or other Medical Officer in any Hospital as the Authorised Medical Attendant certifies to be necessary to such extent and in such manner as the specialist or the Medical Officer may, in consultation with the Authorised Medical Attendant, determine.
- F. **PATIENT** means an employee or a member of HIS/HER family to whom the Regulations apply and who has fallen ill.
- G. **SALARY** means all emoluments drawn by an Employee excluding
- i) Dearness Allowance
 - ii) City Compensatory Allowance
 - iii) House Rent Allowance
 - iv) Conveyance Allowance
 - v) Travelling Allowance
 - vi) Washing Allowance
 - vii) Shift Allowance

H. STATION means the Town or Place within the STATE, in which the Employee falls ill.

I. TREATMENT means the use of all MEDICAL, X -RAY and SURGICAL facilities available at the Hospital and includes :

(1) The employment of such Pathological, Bacteriological, Radiological or any other methods as are considered necessary by the Authorised Medical Consultant;

(2) The supply of such medicines, vaccines, sera or other therapeutic substances are routinely available in the Hospital;

(3) The supply of such medicines, vaccines, sera or other therapeutic substances, as the Authorised Medical Attendant may certify in writing to be essential for the recovery or for the prevention of serious deterioration in the condition of the patient and which are not ordinarily available in the Hospital;

(4) The supply of such quantity of BLOOD as the Authorised Medical Attendant may certify in writing to be essential for the recovery or for the prevention of serious deterioration in the condition of the patient.

NOTE: Prescriptions of expensive drugs, tonics, laxatives or other elegant and proprietary preparations are prohibited for the use of employees and members of their families, when drugs of equal therapeutic value of lesser cost are available.

(5) Treatment for confinement cases - (the wife of an employee/ female employee) treatment towards:
Pregnancy, Child Birth, Miscarriage and Abortion.

(6) Operation for sterilisation and medical termination of pregnancy made in a hospital established or maintained by

Government or a place for the time being approved by the Government under Section - 4 of the medical termination of Pregnancy Act 1971 (Central Act 34 of 1971).

- (7) Such accommodation as is ordinarily provided in the Hospital or Sanatoria and is suited to the status of the employee with reference to his/her salary, as detailed in Appendix - "B".
- (8) Such nursing as is ordinarily provided to the patients by the Hospital; provided that where special nursing becomes necessary it should be considered on MERITS and a refund ADMITTED to the extent justified in each case with the sanction of the Board.
- (9) The Specialist consultation specified in Regulation 3(E) and DIET charges at twenty percent of Ward charges admissible [See Appendix - B] in the case of employee whose salary does not exceed Rs. 1,650-00 per month.

4. DETERMINATION OF THE APPROPRIATE MEDICAL ATTENDANT:

- (a) The Authorised Medical Attendant of an Employee shall be determined with reference to the place at which the employee falls ill, whether at his/her residence or the place of casual stay or the place where he/she may be spending his/her leave.
- (b) For purposes of these Regulations ANY DOCTOR/ MEDICAL OFFICER other than those mentioned in Regulation No. 3(a) shall not be regarded as an Authorised Medical Attendant for any category of employee save in exceptional cases.
- (c) For purposes of these Regulations, the pay and status of an employee under suspension shall be the pay he/she was drawing and the status he/she was holding immediately before the date of suspension.

- (d) In the case of re-employed pensioners, the pay they are drawing after re-employment including the pension shall be taken as the basis for purposes of Medical Attendance and treatment.
- (e) Doctors attached to the local fund Dispensaries and Corporation of City of Bangalore Hospitals/Dispensaries are de-recognised and the medical re-imburement bills signed by such Doctors are not admissible.

5. SPECIAL NURSING:

Special Nurses shall be engaged only with the approval of the Medical Superintendent of the Hospital concerned when their services are absolutely essential and for the minimum period necessary.

For claiming the charges in respect of Special Nursing, the employee shall obtain and produce a certificate in FORM - "A".

6. FREE MEDICAL TREATMENT:

An employee shall ordinarily be entitled, free of charge-

- (a) to treatment in a Hospital or at near the place where the employee falls ill, as can, in the opinion of the Authorised Medical Consultant, provide the necessary and suitable treatment or
- (b) to Anti-rabic treatment at the nearest Hospital Providing such treatment.

7. ADMISSION TO AND TREATMENT IN WARDS:

- (a) An employee who is admitted as an INPATIENT for treatment in a particular class of paying ward or special ward, may get himself/herself treated in any higher class or paying ward. In such cases, only the admissible ward charges shall be allowed.

- (b) An employee, who sustains BURN Injuries while on duty may be admitted in the "AIR CONDITIONED WARD". If available and if so advised by the Medical Attendant, for speedy recovery. The ward charges paid by the employee is fully re-imbursable, as a special case.

8. TREATMENT AT THE RESIDENCES OF EMPLOYEES:

- (1) If the Authorised Medical Attendant is of the opinion that owing to the absence, or remoteness of a suitable hospital or to the severity of the illness an employee cannot be given treatment as provided in regulation No. 7, the employee may received treatment at his/her residence.
- (2) The employee receiving treatment at his/her residence shall be entitled to receive towards the cost of such treatment incurred by him/her a sum equivalent to the cost of such treatment as he/she would have been entitled. Free of charge, to received in an hospital, if he/she had not been treated at his/her residence.
- (3) Claims for sums admissible under regulation No. 9(2) shall be accompanied by a Certificate in writing by the Authorised Medical Attendant stating:
- (a) His/Her reasons for the opinion referred to in Reg. No. 9(1)&
- (b) the cost of similar treatment referred to in Reg. No. 9(2).

9. SPECIAL MEDICAL TREATMENT IN CERTAIN CASES:

- (1) If the Authorised Medical Attendant is of the opinion that the condition of the patient is of such a serious nature or of a special nature as to require Medical Attendance by a Specialist or other Medical Officer or that the Patient requires ANTI-RABIC TREATMENT, the Medical Attendant may,

- a) Send the Patient to the nearest specialist or other Medical Officer as provided in REGN. No. 3 (E) or in the case of ANTI - RABIC TREATMENT to the nearest place where such treatment is available;
 - b) Summon such specialist or other Medical Officer to attend upon the patient, in case the patient is too ill to travel.
- (2) If in exceptional cases, Medical treatment is advised outside the STATE by the Authorised Medical Attendant on account of such treatment being NOT AVAILABLE with in the STATE or for any other reasons, the employee should before availing the treatment, obtain a certificate from the DIRECTOR OF HEALTH & FAMILY WELFARE SERVICES, Govt. of Karnataka or from the Board's Senior Medical Consultants, that such treatment is not available in the STATE and that the patient has to be treated elsewhere or in a particular hospital outside the STATE.
- a) In emergent cases, the certificate may be obtained after treatment but before claiming re-imburement.
 - b) The Medical Bills for such treatment require the counter-signature of the Authorised Medical Attendant or Board's Senior Medical Consultants.

10. TREATMENT OUTSIDE THE STATE:

- (1) Any Employee who is at a place outside the STATE but within the territory of India, either on DUTY or ON DEPUTATION, MAY RECEIVE MEDICAL ATTENDANCE in any Government Hospital of the place, where he/she falls ill or if there is no such Government Hospital, in any other Hospital/institution recognised by the State Government/Board and entitled to recover the costs incurred therefore calculated in accordance with these Regulations, on the production of a certificate from the Medical Officer incharge of such Hospital or Institution.

- (2) Any employee, who is at a place outside the STATE but within the territory of India, either on leave or during the course of a journey, suddenly falls ill and has to receive urgent medical attendance in any Government Hospital or a recognised hospital/institution at the place or nearest to the place where the employee falls ill, may also receive medical attendance under these Regulations, provided the employee gets himself/herself discharged as soon as he/she is certified "FIT" to travel and undertakes to continue the treatment, if need be, within the STATE and provided further that such Medical Attendance shall not include consultation of experts outside the STATE at Board's cost for any particular disease.
- (3) Claims pertaining to the treatment availed by the wife of an employee or by a Female employee during her confinement at a place outside the State may be re-imbursed subject to the following conditions:-
- (a) The Medical Attendant attending on the patient is employed by the local State Government or Corporation or Municipality or Local Body, of the place and
 - (b) the claim, other than the cost of medicines being limited to that amount charged in the karnataka state Government Hospital for similar type of treatment.

- (4) Employees working in the BORDER AREAS OF THE STATE, whenever they or members of their families were to fall ill, may avail Medical attendance /Medical Treatment in an Hospital situated across the STATE'S BORDERS, if it is nearer to them. The cost of Medical Attendance/ Medical treatment in such cases is re-imbursable subject to observance of these Regulations.

FACILITIES FOR T.B. PATIENTS

- 11 a) Any employee, who is suspected to be suffering from 'TUBERCULOSIS', should be sent to the nearest Government T.B.Clinic or T.B. Sanitorium or to the nearest District Head quarters hospital where proper facilities including X-Ray are available for a thorough examination.
- b) Normally NO CHARGES will be levied by those hospitals/ institutions, for X-Ray, SKIAGRAMAS, EXAMINATIONS AND LABORATORY INVESTIGATIONS. IN case such charges are levied, the amount paid by the employees is re-imbursable on production of Receipts and Medical Records.
12. a) If after such examinations, the employee is found to be suffering from TUBERCULOSIS and the case is an ACTIVE ONE, the employee should be granted such period of leave as may be recommended in his/her case by the Authorised Medical Attendant. until the employee has exhausted all kinds of leave, except extra-ordinary leave admissible to him/her under B.E.S.R., for undergoing the treatment.
- b) Before the expiry of the period of leave, the employee shall appear before the Authorised Medical Attendant for a report as to whether the employee is FIT to resume duty. If found FIT, the employee may be taken to duty, on production of Medical Fitness Certificate.
- c) If the Authorised Medical Attendant reports that the employee is NOT FIT to resume duty and certifies that further treatment is necessary, the employee shall be granted extra-ordinary leave, as admissible under B.E.S.R. for such period as may be recommended by the Authorised Medical Attendant subject to a maximum period of TWO years.

- d) If in the opinion of the Authorised Medical Attendant, the employee is UNFIT to resume duty or that there is no likelihood of the employee returning to duty, then the employee shall be RETIRED on grounds of invalidity.
13. (1) Before the expire of maximum limit of Extra-ordinary leave (i.e. two years), the employee concerned shall be got examined by a Medical Board, that may be constituted by the Director of Health & Family welfare, Government of Karnataka, to see whether the Employee is FIT to resume duty or should be invalidated.
- (2) If the Medical Board opines that the Employee has considerably improved, but is found to be in need of some more time, say 1 to 3 months to consolidate the progress and to become FIT to resume duty further leave may be granted subject to the limit of THREE months, provided it is certified that the Employee is likely to resume duty by the end of that period.
- (3) If the Medical Board opines that the Employee is UNFIT to resume duty then the appointing authority may order for the retirement of the Employee on grounds of invalidity.
14. If after careful examination by the Medical Board, the case is declared as 'ARRESTED' and the Employee is considered FIT to resume his/her duties, he/she shall be allowed to continue in his/her appointment under the following conditions:-
- (a) that the employee remains under suitable Medical Supervisor and treatment of the Medical Attendant who should maintain a special register of the case so that the patient is followed up regularly in his/her own interest as well as that of public health.
- (b) that the employee suspected of Tuberculosis or suffering from ARRESTED Tuberculosis shall undergo periodical

re-examination by the proper Medical Officer and if necessary by a competent authority in Tuberculosis approved by the Board.

- 15.** Cases requiring medical examination by the Medical Board, should be referred to the Secretary, K.E.B., with the following particulars:-
1. Name of the employee & designation and Pay & allowances drawn.
 2. Date of Birth and entry into service.
 3. Name of Division/Office.
 4. period of treatment.
 5. If on leave, the period & kinds of leave sanctioned, balance of leave admissible.
 6. Copies of Medical Report/Record to be enclosed.
 7. Amount of medical expenses re-imbursed so far.
 8. Any other particulars.
- 16.** In the event of an employee suffering from Tuberculosis being declared FIT for duty, the concerned Officer shall wherever possible give him/her light duty for another year or so and also allow him/her some period for REST daily or occasionally as advised by the K.E.B. Medical Board of Senior Medical Consultants, if the condition demands.
- 17. (1)** While on leave, the employee shall be required to undergo treatment in Government Medical Institution or in an institution approved by the Board, the Authorised Medical Attendant shall have discretion to decide whether a patient should be asked to stay in a sanatorium or whether the employee should take treatment while staying outside such an institution under such conditions as may be considered necessary.

- (2) Reasonable facilities should also be provided, as far as possible, for admission of the Employees to Hospital/ Institutions provided they are deemed FIT for treatment by the Medical Officer incharge of the T.B. Clinic or Sanitoria. The expenses for the treatment of the employee and for DIET NORMAL, EXTRA OR SPECIAL shall be met wholly by Board in the case of employee whose pay does not exceed Rs. 1,650-00. In the case of employees whose pay exceeds Rs.1,650-00, charges for diet shall be borne by the employees themselves.
- (3) Treatment of employees suffering from Tuberculosis at the Karnataka Health Institute, Ghataprabha or in any other Institution recognised by the Board shall be deemed to be treatment in a Government Medical Hospital and the Employees, in such a case, shall be entitled to get refund of the ward charges and re-imbusement of medical expenses admissible, under these Regulations.
- 18.** (1) Employees undergoing treatment as OUT-PATIENTS in Hospitals/Institutions shall also be entitled to the concessions admissible under REG. NO. 13.
- (2) Vouchers for the special medicines purchases by them, for their treatment, should be produced, duly countersigned by the Authorised Medical Attendant.
- 19.** Persons, who are newly recruited according to the relevant Regulations of Recruitment, should have put in a minimum service of ONE YEAR to become eligible for the concessions admissible under the Regulations relating to 'Facilities for T.B. Patients'.
- 20.** The Controlling Officer, under whom the employee in need of concessions, is serving, is the authority to sanction these concessions.

21. CONVEYANCE CHARGES:

When a journey is undertaken within the same City, Town or other area within the Municipal Body for purposes of obtaining Medical Attendance/Medical Treatment and the distance travelled is more than EIGHT Kms. each way, the patient shall be entitled to conveyance charges limited to Road metrage admissible to an Employee under Regulation 333-A of B.E.S.R. Provided it is certified by the Authorised Medical Attendant that it was necessary for the patient to travel by conveyance for purposes of obtaining Medical Attendance/Medical Treatment.

22. TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE:

- (1) When a journey is undertaken to obtain Medical Advice, the Travelling Allowance shall be regulated as per regulation 388 of B.E.S.R.
- (2) If the patient is unable to travel due to serious illness and it is considered that it is unsafe for the patient to travel unattended, the person accompanying the patient is entitled to travelling allowance. The T.A. in such cases shall be regulated as per Regulation 395 of B.E.S.R.
- (3) A patient, sent to a Specialist or other Medical Officer or to the place where Anti-Rabic treatment is available, under Regulation 10, is entitled to Travelling Allowance to & from the Head - quarters of the Specialist/other Medical Officer/ the place where the Anti-Rabic treatment is available. The T.A. in such cases shall be regulated as per Regulation 388 or 333 -A of B.E.S.R.
- (4) Where a journey is undertaken to procure Artificial Appliances, the travelling allowance shall be regulated as per Regulation 388 or 333-A of B.E.S.R.
- (5) In all the above cases, the patient should obtain the certificate from the Authorised Medical Attendant/Specialist or Medical Officer/Appropriate Officer of the Hospital/ Institution and attach it to the T.A. claims.

23. COUNTERSIGNATURE OF T.A. BILLS:

The Controlling Officer of a patient may require any certificate required to be given by the Authorised Medical Attendant to be countersigned by an authority superior to the one who has given the certificate.

24. REIMBURSEMENT OF MEDICAL EXPENSES:

Subject to observance of these Regulations:

- (1) The amount of Medical Expenses incurred by the Employees for obtaining Medical Attendance/Medical Treatment in Government Medical Hospitals/Institutions for themselves or for the Members of their families (either as out-patients or in-patients) is re-imbursable.
- (2) Where the Medical Attendance/Treatment is obtained in private Hospitals/Institutions recognised by the Board. the amount of re-imbursement of medical expenses incurred by the employee excluding the cost of medicines shall be limited to the amount charged in Government Medical Hospitals/ Institution for similar treatment. The cost of admissible items of medicines is fully re-imbursable.

EXCEPTION:- Accident cases -

where as employee sustains severe/serious injuries (PHYSICAL/ BURNS) while on duty, the injured employee shall be taken/admitted to the nearest Hospital for immediate medicare. (REFER PARAS 525 & 526 OF ACCOUNTS MANUAL VOLUME - II)

Re-imbursement of Medical Expenses in all such cases require sanction of the Board.

- (3) Where an employee, who is entitled to medical treatment in any reconginsed Hospital FREE OF CHARGE under Regulation No. 7 is charged for the treatment, the amount of such treatment is re-imbursable on production of Receipt/ Bill.

- (4) (a) The cost of preparations, which are not medicines but are primarily FOODS, TONICS, TOILET PREPARATIONS, DISINFECTANTS, etc., specified in LISTS B & C is not reimbursable.
- (b) The items, allopathic medicines and preparations specified in LIST 'A' indicate ineligible medicines and preparations (it is not exhaustive). Hence, the cost of such medicines and preparations is not re-imbursable. In doubtful cases, the Senior Medical Consultant may take a decision as to whether a particular medicine or preparation falls under any of the categories specified in LISTS 'A', 'B' & 'C' and as to its admissibility or other wise for purposes of reimbursement of the cost of the medicines/preparations .
- (c) The cost of any therapeutic substance included in these lists, which is prescribed by the Authorised Medical Attendant is RE-IMBURSABLE provided it is certified by the Authorised Medical Attendant that such therapeutic substance was absolutely essential for the recovery of the patient and counter-signed by Board's Senior Medical Consultant.
- (d) The cost of the following medical preparations is RE-IMBURSABLE provided it is certified by the Authorised Medical Attendant to the effect that such medical preparation is a must for the treatment of the disease for saving the life of the patient.
- (e) Some of the medicines which are usually not admissible as per K.E.B. Rules, may be reimbursed by the approval of Senior Medical Consultants in exceptional deserving cases where the medicines are found to be absolutely necessary in the interest of the patient.

The panel of Senior Medical Consultants may decide the necessity of even admissible drugs and disallow them regarding the quality and quantity.

- (5) (a) Sales Tax paid by the Employees while purchasing special medicines from the market is REIMBURSABLE.
- (b) Packing & Postage charges paid by the Employees for purchasing special medicines from OUTSTATIONS are NOT REIMBURSABLE.
- (6) If an Ambulance is used to convey a patient to a place of treatment or to convey a patient from one Hospital to another Hospital for purposes of certain medical examination etc., the charges paid by the employees on that account are REIMBURSABLE.
- (7) Charges paid by the Employee for sterilisation of instruments used in connection with operation performed are NOT REIMBURSABLE.
- (8) Theatre & Anaesthesia charges, if paid by the Employee, are NOT REIMBURSABLE. [D.H & F.W.S.L tr. No. MDA198/85 - 86/ 5.8.85]
- (9) The cost of the blood purchased for being administered to the patient on the advice of the Authorised Medical Attendant is REIMBURSABLE on production of a Certificate by the Authorised Medical Attendant or by the treating Physician.
- (10) In cases where for lack of facilities at a Government Hospital/ Institution or in the Laboratory attached to it, Skiagrams (X-Rays) or E.C.G's are taken at a Private Hospital or a Private Laboratory, the charges incurred thereon are reimbursable at the rates prevalent in Govt. Hospitals/Institutions.
- (11) Cost of Anti-Rabic Vaccines purchased for treatment towards suspected Rabies Prophylactic is NOT REIMBURSABLE. [D.H & F.W.S. Ltr. No. MDA. 14/86-87/24.4.1986]

(12) Physiotherapy treatment is being given at Government Hospitals, FREE OF COST. Hence, Charges paid towards such treatment are NOT REIMBURSABLE.

[D.H & F.W.S. Ltr. No . MDA. 571/85 - 86/ 10.3.1986]

(13) Expenses incurred towards treatment of INFERTILITY CASES are NOT REIMBURSABLE.

(14) The cost of Ayurvedic, Unani & Homeopathic Medicines is REIMBURSABLE.

The List of items for which refund is admissible in respect of Ayurvedic, Unani & Homeopathic Medicines taken in Govt. Institutions or approved Institutions, shall be those published by the Director of Indian System of Medicines & Homeopathy.

(15) Expenses incurred for procuring artificial appliances including travelling expenses and hospitalisation charges, if any, are reimbursable provided that the Officer-in-charge of the Medical Institution where the employee has undergone the treatment certifies that such appliances were absolutely essential for the treatment of the employee.

Explanation:

Artificial appliance means

- a) Prosthetic appliances of all kinds for the upper and lower limbs.
- b) Spinal braces or spinal supports including spinal belts.
- c) Cervical collors of all kinds such as of plastic, leather or stainless steel with leather coverings.
- d) Feather and metallic splints devised for correction of deformities and providing support for upper limits.
- e) Bracerage of all kinds including calipers, keen cage, Knock knee and bow legs splints made of metal & leather.

- f) Orthopaedic shoes, boots and splints used for correction of deformities of feet and legs.
(A list of artificial appliances appended)
- (16) a) Refund in respect of the cost of POLIO BOOTS shall be allowed only at intervals of NOT LESS THAN THREE YEARS and may be claimed only three times in respect of an individual.
- b) Refund in respect of machinery appliances like crutches, limb supporters, etc., shall be allowed only if they are purchased from a Medical College/Hospital (Rehabilitation Department) or from the Artificial Body (parts) Centre at pune or from any other centre/Organisation recognised and approved by Central/State Governments or Board for such purposes, both in the cases of Polio Boots and Machinery appliances.
 - c) The refund is subject to the condition that it is certified by the concerned Specialist as ESSENTIAL.
- (17) a) Refund in respect of FULL SET OF DENTURES where necessary shall be allowed upto a maximum of Rs. 200/- (Rs. Two hundred only) to an employee and to each Member of his/her family once during the entire service of the employee.
- b) Refund in respect of replacement of teeth in cases other than those falling under (17a) shall be allowed as and when necessary.

Provided that NO REFUND under 17-a or 17-b shall be allowed where the Dentures Or Teeth are made of any material like GOLD, SILVER, etc.
 - c) Refund in respect of scaling or filling of the teeth or for any treatment taken for disease connected with teeth shall be allowed.

18) a) **Testing of Eyesight for Glasses:**

Employees and Members of their family may have their EYE SIGHT tested for glasses at Government or recognised Hospitals once in THREE YEARS on the recommendation of the Authorised Medical Attendant. Fees, if paid, to the Specialist for such services may be REIMBURSED according to the rates charges in Govt. Hospitals.

b) Refund in respect of the cost of spectacles where necessary shall be allowed once in THREE Years to an employee and to each Member of His/her family subject to the condition that the amount claimed in each case does not exceed a maximum of Rs. 150/- instead of Rs. 100/- due to escalated rate of glass.

c) Cost of Contact lens is not reimbursable.

(19) Refund in respect of purchase of hearing aid shall be allowed to the extent of Rs. 300-00 (Rs. Three hundred only) once during the entire service of the employee subject to the following conditions and dependents having hard of hearing.

a) This benefit is admissible to the employee, it is not admissible to the family members of the employee and dependent children with hearing defect.

b) The reimbursement of the charges will be admissible on the basis of the certificate issued by the Head of ENT Department in a Government Hospital. The certificate should specify that the employee is required to use Hearing Aid for his/her right ear left ear.

c) The employee should make use of the Hearing Aid in the course of discharge of his/her normal official duties.

- (20) Refund in respect of purchase of pace maker shall be allowed subject to the condition that the Officer - in - charge of the Medical Institution certifies that implantation of pace maker is absolutely essential for treatment of the employee.
- (21) In Cardiac cases, or in cases of Respiratory failures, Oxygen is administered. In such cases, cost of oxygen is reimbursable at the rate of J.I.C., Bangalore.

25. CLAIMS FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF MEDICAL EXPENSES:

- 1)
 - a) Claims for Reimbursement of Medical Expenses shall be preferred in Form-C and shall be presented in a complete form to the Pay Drawing Officer within a period of halfyearly from the date of commencement of treatment.
 - b) Claims preferred after ONE YEAR but within a period NOT EXCEEDING TWO YEARS shall be subjected to INTERNAL CHECK by the chief Controller of Accounts (Internal Audit).
 - c) Claims preferred after TWO YEARS require sanction of the BOARD.
 - d) There shall be a seperate application for each patient.
- (2) Medical claims on behalf of Deceased Employees shall be preferred by the Nominees/legal heirs. Such claims shall be dealt with and paid in the same manner and under the same conditions applicable for the payment of Salary, Leave salary, Allowances, etc., due to a deceased employee. [Refer para - 500 of Accounts Manual Vol. II].
- (3) The claims for reimbursement of Medical expenses shall be supported by:
 - a) Prescription in original.
 - b) Cash Memos for Medicines/Preparations purchased

duly countersigned by the Doctor who has prescribed the Medical preparations.

- c) Essentiality Certificate in Form-B duly filled in and signed by the Authorised Medical Attendant.
 - d) Hospital Receipts/Vouchers, Medical Records and Discharge Certificate in the cases of Inpatients.
 - e) Declarations/Certificates in the prescribed forms, furnished by the Employees in respect of Medical Expenses incurred by the Members of their families.
 - f) Each bill must be countersigned by Head of the Hospital/Head of the Institutions or approved Hospitals.
- (4) Claims for refunds of EYESIGHT testing charges and claims for refunds of the cost of spectacles, upto the prescribed limits shall be supported by an Essentiality Certificate signed by the Authorised Medical Attendant, prescriptions, cash receipts and a declaration by the employee in Form-D.
- (5) Claims for reimbursement of expenses towards Dentures or teeth shall be supported by an Essentiality Certificate from the Authorised Medical Attendant and a declaration by the employee in Form-E.

NOTE: The Essentiality Certificate signed and vouchers countersigned by both Senior and Junior Medical Consultants of the Board in respect of prescriptions of glasses and extraction of tooth/teeth and supply of dentures by Private Doctors may be accepted for purposes of reimbursement of the charges incurred therefore by the employees but limited to Government rates. [A1/4943/73-74/3.8.1974].

- (6) Claims by employees who are on duty, deputation, leave or travelling in any place outside the State but within the territory of India (Refer Regn. 11) shall be supported by proper receipts and vouchers countersigned and certified by the Authorised Medical Attendant to the effect that the treatment was necessary and the charges are reasonable having regard to the circumstances of the case. All such claims for reimbursement require sanction of the Board.
- (7) Allopathic drugs prescribed by physicians, Surgeons, Medical Officers and Regd. Practitioners are not valid for reimbursement.

26. PROCEDURE/GUIDELINES:

- (1) Employees and the Members of their families are required to obtain medical attendance/medical treatment in Government Medical Hospitals/Institutions or in the Private Hospitals/Institutions recognised by the Board. Then only they are entitled to claim reimbursement of medical expenses incurred by them under these Regulations.
- (2) a) In Bangalore SEVEN qualified Doctors have been appointed as Board's Junior Medical Consultants on part-time basis for the convenience of the employees working in Bangalore and their families. Each Doctor will visit TWICE A WEEK the particular Division/Office to which the Doctor is assigned. The Employees working in the respective Divisions/Offices may approach the concerned Junior Medical Consultant for medical consultancy/medical treatment.
- b) The Junior Medical Consultants can issue physical Fitness Certificate to the newly recruited employees and also medical certificates to the employees if requisitioned. They shall also attend to such other duties as may be entrusted to them by the Board pertaining to their profession.

- (3) The Board has also appointed FOUR SPECIALISTS as Senior Medical consultants on part-time basis for scrutiny of medical reimbursement bills. They are also available for Medical consultancy. They constitute Board's Medical panel for offering medical opinion. They shall also attend to such other duties as may be entrusted to them by the Board pertaining to their profession.
- (4) The family members of those employees working in any Offices/ O & M Units/Stations located in Bangalore Corporation area limits, Peenya and Hoody may approach any of the Junior Medical Consultants for medical consultancy/medical treatment at the offices nearest to their Residence.
- (5) The family members of those employees working Outside Bangalore but residing in Bangalore may also approach the Junior Medical Consultants for medical consultancy/medical treatment and to obtain their signature on cash memos and Essentiality Certificates. Such claims may be accepted and paid after due scrutiny by the respective Pay Drawing Officers.
- (6) The Junior Medical Consultants should not prescribe medicines for a period exceeding FIVE DAYS as it may be quite unsafe for the patients to receive treatment for a longer period without proper diagnostic tests.
- (7) In exceptional cases, the medicines for TWO more days may be prescribed.

EXCEPTION: This limitation is relaxed in the cases of all chronic patients suffering from chronic Bronchitis /Bronchial Asthma, Diabetics, Epilepsy, Hypertension, Ischemic Heart Diseases, chronic skin diseases, Tuberculosis, etc. In all such case the patient should be strictly advised to get periodical assessments atleast once in six months or earlier by the appropriate Specialists. It is only after such exercise that the

bills are to be entertained which should be ensured that supporting medical records are enclosed to the bill.

- (8) The Doctor should prescribe the medicine in the prescribed form with correct dosage.
- (9) If the disease persists even after SEVEN DAYS treatment, the patient may be advised to consult some other Doctor attached to a recognised Hospital competent to treat the AILMENT or advised to undergo such diagnostic tests are considered necessary for determining the line of further treatment.
- (10) The employees should hand over the applications in Form-C duly filled in and signed together with cash Memos and prescription slips to their pay Drawing Officers. **THEY SHOULD NOT FILL IN THE ESSENTIALITY CERTIFICATE.** It will be the responsibility of the Pay Drawing Officer to ensure that the cash Memos are countersigned and the Essentiality Certificate duly filled in and signed by the concerned Junior Medical Consultant within SEVEN DAYS.
- 11) a) Where the Employees/Members of their families obtained medical treatment (either as an Outpatient or as an Inpatient) in a Govt. Hospital or any other Hospital recognised by the Board, they should get the Essentiality Certificate signed and the Cash Memos/Vouchers countersigned by the Attending Doctors or by the Medical Superintendents of such Hospitals.
b) They should hand over the applications in Form-C together with all the enclosures to the pay Drawing Officers.
- (12) Medical reimbursement bills upto and inclusive of Rs. 100/- per patient may be paid by the Drawing Officers after due scrutiny of the claims.
- (13) Where an employee/a member of his/her family obtain medical treatment as an Inpatient in a Government Hospital or in a

Government medical Institution (such as NIMHANS, Kidwai Memorial Institute of Oncology, Sri Jayadeva Institute of Cardiology), the medical expenses incurred there for irrespective the amount of the bill may be reimbursed after due scrutiny by the Senior Medical Consultant before payment.

(14) Where treatments were obtained in Private Hospital/Institution recognised by the Board as Inpatients, the Medical Expenses may also be reimbursed irrespective of the amount of the bill by the pay Drawing Officers, after scrutiny by the Senior Medical Consultants but limiting the charges to the rates charged in Government Hospitals.

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(15) The Medical reimbursement bills shall be sent to the Secretary, KEB in the following cases for referring them to Senior Medical Consultants:

1. Where the amount of the Medical reimbursement bill exceeds Rs. 100/- 500/-
2. Where the Bills are referred to Senior Medical Consultants by the Junior Medical Consultants. In Such case the Junior Medical Consultant shall indicate the reason on the bill.
3. Bills relating to Special treatments.
4. Medical claims which are suspicious or excessive.

NOTE : Medical Reimbursement bills in respect of Inpatient cases should not be sent to Senior Medical Consultants.

[B6/1455/91-92/III dated 3.10.1991].

(16) Before sending the bills to the Secretary, the pay Drawing Officers should ensure that:

- a) The application in Form-C is duly filled properly of all columns completely and signed by the Employee.
- b) the Essentiality Certificate is duly filled in (duly indicating the correct diagnosis, period of treatment) and signed by the authorised Medical Attendant.

- c) the prescription in original and cash memos duly countersigned by the authorised Medical Attendant with seal Reg. No., medical records wherever necessary are attached to the bill.
 - d) Bills returned with observations, not completely attended in all terms will be totally disallowed.
- (17) The bills of one Division/Office located in Bangalore should be sent through a responsible Official (preferably the case Worker) on Wednesdays and Saturdays.
- (18) In the case of other Divisions/Offices, each bill with cash Memos and other enclosures should be securely stitched. All the bills shall be neatly arranged before packing and sending them by Regd. Post.
- (19) When bills are returned with objections, the pay Drawing Officers should carefully analyse the objections and return the bills with appropriate replies/medical records. If diligent care is taken by the pay Drawing Officers, objections and postal charges could be minimised.

27. SCRUTINY OF CLAIMS:

The Controlling Officers/Pay Drawing Officers should scrutinise the claims very carefully and shall satisfy themselves that the claims are genuine and are covered by these Regulations before submitting to Senior Medical Consultants of Board.

28. The claims should be checked and passed in the manner indicated hereunder:

1. The application in Form-C is completely filled in and signed by the Employee/claimant.
2. relevant declaration in the prescribed form is given by the employee in respect of:
 - a) Medical expenses incurred by spouse if employed in Board or elsewhere.

- b) Medical expenses incurred by the dependent Parent.
 - c) Eye testing charges.
 - d) Cost of Spectacles
 - e) Cost of Dentures.
 - f) Where Special Nursing services availed.
3. The original prescription is enclosed.
 4. The Essentiality certificate is duly filled in and signed by the Authorised Medical Attendant.
 5. The claims are supported by cash Memos/Vouchers.
 6. To ensure that:
 - a) the medicines/preparations have been purchased from a Licensed Chemist/Druggist and are according to the prescriptions.
 - b) They are countersigned by the Authorised Medical Attendant.

NOTE : Cash Memos with back dates and the authorised Medical Attendant signing such Cash Memos is a serious irregularity.

7. Check the medicines/preparations purchased with the list of inadmissible items.
8. Check the quantum of medicine purchased with reference to the prescriptions.

Example: If tablets are prescribed at 1-1-1(3 tablets) per day for 5 days, the employee should have purchased (3 × 5) 15 tablets only.

9. Check the prescription to ensure that the medicines are prescribed initially for a period of 5 days.
10. IN the case of REGULAR CLAIMANTS check the amount of medical expenses with the claims of previous three or four months to ensure that the claims are not excessive.

11. The claims which are suspicious or excessive shall be referred to the Board.
12. In respect of Inpatient cases, hospital bills with breakup details, receipts and discharge certificate are enclosed.
13. In case the treatment is obtained in a Government Hospital/ Institution as an Inpatient:
 - a) Cost of admissible items of medicines/preparations is fully reimbursable.
 - b) Cost of medical treatment is fully reimbursable.
 - c) Ward Charges are to be allowed at admissible rates.
14. In case the treatment is obtained in a recognised Private Hospital/Institution as an Inpatient:
 - a) Cost of admissible items of medicines/preparations is reimbursable after scrutiny by Senior Medical Consultants Panel.
 - b) Cost of medical treatment is to be limited to the rates charged in Government Hospitals for similar treatment.
 - c) Ward Charges are to be allowed at admissible rates.
15. After checking the claims, the Cash Memos/Vouchers should be en faced with checked, admitted/disallowed and attested with the dated initials of the Case Worker and the Assistant Accounts Officer.
16. An Office Order indicating the amounts of medical expenses reimbursable shall be issued.
17. After the issue of the said Order, the amounts due to the employees irrespective of Ranks/Groups should be drawn on Establishment Pay Bills and disbursed to them.
18. All the Cash Memos/Vouchers should be impressed with cancellation stamp and duly attested with dated initials of the Assistant Accounts Officer.

29. RELAXATION OF THE REGULATIONS:

Where the Board is satisfied that the operation of any of these Regulations causes undue hardship in any particular case, it may by ~~order~~ ^{order} dispense with or relax the requirement of that Regulation to such extent and subject to such conditions, as it ~~may~~ ^{may} consider necessary for dealing with any case in a just and ~~equitable~~ ^{equitable} manner.
